The generous Telstra grant will allow the Hunter Wildlife Rescue group to establish infrastructure for the future disaster recovery associated with bushfire, storm, floods, oil spills and heat stress of native fauna across the Hunter region.

This will include building and launching a disaster co-ordination centre at the new Hunter Wildlife Rescue Centre, located in the Hunter Wetlands Centre. Disaster response and field support for search and rescue activities will be also be improved.
